===== Special Activity Weekly Schedule ‘Sample’ =====

Monday	Craft	Students will make crafts related to the theme.
Tuesday	Field Trip	Students will go to a park within walking distance of their school. In case of rain, students will have indoor activities (Students in young class will have water play, or go to the park nearby).
Wednesday	Cooking	Students will engage in cooking related to the theme.
Thursday	Field Trip	Same as Tuesday.
Friday	Review	Back-up day for unfinished crafts, sports activities in a nearby park or indoor games.

- ★ For those applying for all 5 courses/A~E courses staying until 14:00pm, the regular fee would be **¥208,000** in total. **However, only English Express students are eligible for the discount of 20%, making a total price of ¥166,400.**
- ★ Those applying for more than 2 courses are eligible for a 10% discount on the participation fee (Except for Young ① class).
- ★ Only English Express students are eligible for Young ①, ② classes. These classes will not be available if less than 3 students apply. In that case, we will either move them to the same class at another school, or refund your money.
- ★ More than 2 days in the same course will be required to apply.
- ★ Early-Morning Acceptance service is available starting at 8:30 a.m., and the fee is 400 yen per use. For those staying until 14:00, we will provide an Extension service up until 18:00 in a multi-age class. It will be 500 yen per hour, if you apply for Extension in advance with participation in Summer Camp. If an Extension request is placed on the same day (after your payment has been made), a minimum reservation of 2 children is required, as well as a minimum of 2 hours per child, incurring a minimum charge of ¥1,000 per child in cash.

◆ Application & Payment Schedule

- Application Start Date and Time: **Thursday, May 22nd, 2026, 8:50 ~**
- Application deadline : **Thursday, July 2nd, 2026**
- Payment deadline : **Friday, July 3rd, 2026**

- If you wish to participate, please apply by Thursday, July 2nd. After vacancy has been confirmed, a certificate of application will be issued. After you have received your certificate, we ask that you transfer the participation fees within a week.
- For those applying around the deadline date, payments will need to be made by Friday, July 3rd.
- Upon receipt of payment, a confirmation e-mail will be sent if required.
- Application is on a first-come, first-serve basis and will not be accepted after classes have reached the capacity.
- Although at least 2 days from the same course are required to apply, those who apply for 5 days in a week will take priority over those who apply for 2 days in a week. Therefore, there will be a possibility that we can't accommodate your application. After the application deadline of July 2nd, we will confirm availability to those applying for less than 5 days in a week. If there is vacant position left, a certificate of your application will be handed to you and we ask you to transfer the participation fee by Monday, July 6th.
- For those applying for the daily rate, once an available position has been confirmed, we will fill in the position in the order that the application was submitted.
- After the number of students have been confirmed, we will inform you of the schedule and other details by Tue. July 14th. If you do not receive these details by then, please contact us.

- ◆ **Payment Method :** Within one week after application approval, please make a payment to one of the two accounts under your child's name.

- Note) 1. If you are using Internet Banking, the school's name should be entered using large katakana characters only.

◆ Important Notices

1. School T-shirts must be worn. If you do not have one, please purchase one for 1,500yen. Sizes are available in 120, 130, 140. Adult size M is also available to purchase for 1,700yen.
2. Only children who are toilet trained may attend. (Not applicable to young class)
3. If parents are late to the designated pick-up time, you will be charged an extended daycare fee of 250 yen if it is within 15 minutes of the pick-up time and 1,000 yen after the 15 minutes, considered as Extension Class.
4. Regarding Lunch, please prepare a packed lunch. Lunch orders are also available; however, for the Regular class, orders are not available on outing days (Tuesdays and Thursdays) due to hygiene considerations. On Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays, lunch may be ordered at **¥410 per meal (for younger children)** and **¥520 per meal (for elementary school students, same portion size as adults)**. Students in Young class may place lunch orders on all weekdays. If you wish to order lunch, please indicate your preferred dates on the application form. Any additions or changes to lunch orders must be notified by **12:00 PM on the previous business day**. Elementary school students with smaller appetites may also order the **¥410 (younger children's portion)**. Please note that Preschool and Kindergarten students usually place individual orders online; however, during the Summer Camp period, all lunch orders will be arranged through the school. Therefore, please refrain from placing orders via the web.
5. Please understand that Camp, Extension, Lunch and T-shirt fees will not be refunded.
6. In the case where the school is closed due to natural disaster, the fees will not be refunded.
7. In the event of rain, or if the maximum temperature exceeds 31°C, outdoor activities may be suspended and replaced with indoor activities or water play outside. We appreciate your understanding in advance. If the Wet Bulb Globe Temperature (WBGT) exceeds 31, outdoor activities will be canceled and replaced with indoor activities.
